The proposed committee amendment reads: The term of the member who is a member of the faculty of an institution of higher learning under the control of the board shall be for two years. The membership position held by a faculty member shall rotate among the institutions of higher learning under the control of the board and the institutions whose faculty members shall serve the first and second two-year terms on the board shall be determined by lot.
