** COUNCIL: Each college is entitled to one member. Voting population of each college divided by 170 (2045/12=170, without Grad College) to determine additional members.

All members of the Senate from these colleges will be eligible for election to the Council, with the exception of any newly-elected members who have just completed terms on the Council. A Senate member cannot serve more than 6 consecutive years. A Council member cannot serve more than 3 consecutive years.
