Charter

(From the University Operations Manual)

10.081 Membership.

Confirmed by the President of the University:

- A. Five members appointed by the governing body of the faculty, currently the Faculty Senate:
- B. Three members appointed by the governing body of the students, currently for the purposes of this committee, the UISG;
- C. Three members appointed by the governing body of the staff, currently the Staff Council.

10.082 Charge to the Committee.

- A. The Committee shall be governed by the terms of the General Charter.
- B. In addition, the Committee shall:
 - 1. Advise on the establishment of general policies for the orderly, efficient and attractive development of the University's physical campus and facilities, giving particular attention to aesthetic and ecological considerations;
 - 2. Advise on proposals for major development or building projects and proposals for major revisions in ongoing projects, giving consideration to compatibility with existing standards and policies and site selection;
 - 3. Advise on policies of space allocation and utilization, major modification or reallocations of existing facilities and the response to development proposals of all affected elements of the University.
