Recommendations, if any, to the shared governance groups.	Funding is stagnant and even going down as speaking fees have increased astronomically post-COVID. We do not have the funding we did 30 years ago to bring big-name speakers like universities of our caliber continue to do. We work to obtain sponsorships on every event and have a few partnerships but it is not enough to try and bring 6-12 valuable speakers per year on a 100k starting budget.
