\*\*SENATE: Each college except the Graduate College is entitled to one representative. The number of additional representatives is calculated by dividing the entire number of faculty eligible to vote (2946) by 60; the quotient (49) is divided into the total number of voting faculty members of each college.

\*\*\*COUNCIL: Each college except the Graduate College is entitled to one member. Colleges whose faculty membership exceeds one-twelfth of the total number of faculty eligible to vote (246) are entitled to one additional Council member, those whose faculty exceeds two-twelfths are entitled to two additional members, etc.
